

PRIVACY POLICY

(Aurizon Technology Limited — Website)

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) explains how Aurizon Technology Limited and its affiliates (“Aurizon”, “we”, “us”) collect, use, disclose, and protect personal data relating to visitors, prospects, clients, and counterparties (“you”). By using our website or providing information to us, you agree to this Policy.

2. Information We Collect

We may collect: (a) technical data from your device and browser (e.g., IP address, access times, pages viewed); (b) identification and contact details (e.g., name, date of birth, nationality, ID/passport details, phone, email, address); (c) transaction and financial data (e.g., payments, bank or wallet details, source-of-wealth documents); and (d) communications with us (e.g., calls, emails, messages, social media). We may also collect information about your authorised representatives and, for corporates, directors, beneficial owners, and employees.

3. Purpose and Legal Basis

We use personal data to: (a) perform due diligence and regulatory checks (where relevant); (b) manage relationships and respond to enquiries; (c) process transactions and perform agreements; (d) meet legal, regulatory, risk, and crime-prevention obligations; and (e) operate, support, improve, and secure our systems and services. Legal bases include performance of a contract, legal obligations, legitimate interests, and your consent where required.

4. Protecting Your Data

We apply organisational and technical measures designed to protect personal data against unauthorised or unlawful processing, and accidental loss, destruction, or damage. Access is limited to personnel who need it for legitimate business purposes and are subject to confidentiality obligations.

5. Sharing Your Data

We may share data: (a) within the Aurizon group; (b) with payment processors and financial institutions; (c) with service providers and professional advisers under appropriate contractual safeguards; (d) with your authorised representatives; (e) with regulators, law enforcement, and authorities where required; and (f) with prospective buyers or merger partners in connection with corporate transactions.

6. International Transfers

Your data may be processed in other countries. Where we transfer data internationally, we take steps intended to ensure a reasonable standard of protection in accordance with applicable law.

7. Retention

We keep personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes described or as required by law and regulation, including for record-keeping, audits, compliance, dispute resolution, fraud monitoring, and to respond to complaints.

8. Access and Correction

You may request access to, or correction of, personal data we hold about you. A reasonable fee may apply for access. We aim to respond within a reasonable timeframe and will inform you if we need more time or cannot fulfil a request where permitted by law.

9. Withdrawing Consent

Where processing relies on consent, you may withdraw it by emailing us. We will explain any consequences (e.g., if we can no longer provide certain services) and process the request within a reasonable period.

10. Accuracy

11. Cookies

We may use cookies or similar technologies for site operation and analytics. You can disable or delete cookies via your browser settings, but some site features may not function properly.
